Hyatt Regency Maui Resort and Spa Caters to Families This Summer

Kids Stay and Eat Free while enjoying abundance of recreational activities

KA'ANAPALI, Maui, Hawaii – April 17, 2007 –Hyatt Regency Maui Resort and Spa today introduced the “Kids Eat Free” program for children 12 and under, for families now making reservations over the summer months for at least four nights from June 11 through August 25.

A “Kids Eat Free” meal is available for breakfast, lunch and dinner for every accompanying paying adult* at four of the resort restaurants including poolside at Pavillion for breakfast or lunch, Swan Court which offers breakfast buffet or plated breakfast service, and for dinner with fine dining at Son’z Maui at Swan Court or casual at Spats Trattoria offering Northern Italian cuisine. Children can select from the “Johnny Venture” menu or the existing Children’s Menu when ordering.

In addition children aged 18 and under stay free in the same room as their parents, using available room bedding, with a maximum of four people allowed in one room.

Hyatt Regency Maui emphasizes family fun and cultural experiences by offering activities such as **lei making** and **hula dancing lessons**, as well as nightly torch lighting and sounds of the conch. The resort also offers a **Wildlife Tour** introducing guests to the native animals living at the resort including parrots, penguins, flamingos, and cranes.

The resort features “**Keiki Lagoon,**” a 3,000 square foot interactive children’s pool surrounded by sand, lava rocks, dolphin and turtle sculptures, and a sand-covered island sitting at the center of the pool amidst leaping water fountains. The pool also offers a 25-foot water slide and a swinging rope bridge.

Children can also enjoy **Camp Hyatt**, a child’s fun and educational activity program introduced in 1989 setting an industry standard, which meets daily from 9 a.m.

to 3 p.m. and 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. for children ages 5 to 12 years. Indoor and outdoor activities on property include lei making, learning the hula, Hawaiian games, coconut bowling, fishing, picture taking, stories and crafts, building sand castles, creating a scrapbook, and more.

In addition, guests have access to an extensive Cranium Game Library available at the resort. Created with offerings for visitors of every age, including Cranium favorites like Cranium Hullabaloo™ and Cranium Zigity™, Regency Club guests can order complimentary games through the Regency Club concierge to play poolside after a dip, in their suite before bed or while lounging with the family at the Regency Club.
